Items Not to Flush Down the Toilet

Cotton balls, cotton pad, Q-tips, baby wipes, flushable wipes, menstrual products, condoms, diapers, dental floss, paper towels and tissues, medication, cigarette butts, kitty litter, hair, gum, cooking grease, fish, bleach, flushable toilet bowl cleaning heads, makeup remover wipes, batteries, fluorescent lights bulbs and tubes, mercury thermometers, thermostats, solvent-based glue, paint, strippers, wood preservatives, nail polish, antifreeze (unless non-toxic, environmentally friendly), engine cleaners, degreasers, gasoline, motor oil, fertilizers, pesticides, pool and spa water, pool chemicals, fats, oils, and grease.

It's a Toilet, Not a Trash Can!

Never flush the following items (or put down the garbage disposal or drain). Toss them in the trash instead.

- Baby/Facial/Cleaning Wipes
- Tampons
- Sanitary Napkins
- Medication
- Hair
- Dental Floss
- Cotton Swabs/Balls
- Bandages
- Rags and Towels
- Rubber Items (like latex gloves)
- Fat, Cooking Oil, Grease



- Clothing Labels
- Candy/Food Wrappers
- Syringes
- Cigarette Butts
- Disposable Toilet Brushes
- Kitty Litter
- Aquarium Gravel
- Plastic Items
- Diapers
- Fruit Stickers
- Paper Towels

Only Flush the 3 P's - Pee, Poop and (toilet) Paper
