Fresno County Ballots to Arrive at Fresno Postal Center 465,000 official ballots will be arriving via truck for the MARCH 3, 2020 ELECTION

Fresno, **CA**--Join Fresno County Clerk/Registrar of Voters Brandi Orth and Evelina Ramirez from the USPS, on the docks at the downtown Fresno Postal Center as approximately 68 pallets, holding 465,000 verified ballots, begin to arrive.

Trucks, loaded with Fresno County's 465,000 ballots, will be pulling in to the Postal Center docks to unload the ballots, which are scheduled for delivery via the US mail, that week. As part of the Voter's Choice Act, all voters will receive a Vote-by-Mail ballot which can be returned by postage-free mail, drop off boxes, or vote centers, which will be equitably distributed throughout the county. Vote centers will provide a high level of service. Ten vote centers will be open 11 days and the remaining 43 vote centers will be open for 4 days, including weekends.
