Submission of bids electronically is encouraged. While submitting paper bid bonds and paper bids are still possible, we encourage electronic bid submission and the bid opening itself will take place over Zoom. The software used by the County, Bid Express, is free to submit bids for County Public Works & Planning projects but contractors need to select "Pay as you go" to avoid paying subscription fees. In addition, the software allows for saving, submitting, and resubmitting your bids and only the bid that is submitted at the time of the bid opening will be viewed by County staff. The very top section of the Pepperweed Road, for example has been measured as up to 22% grade in some areas. It is important that the entire project be completed and if the prime contractor is unable to perform the work, they are responsible to come up with remedies that will result in the road being chipped.
