- SUBJECT: RESOLUTION NO. 12937 THIRD ONE-YEAR TIME EXTENSION FOR VESTING TENTATIVE TRACT MAP NO. 5430
  - APPLICANT: Jeffrey T. Roberts
  - OWNER: Assemi Group
  - REQUEST: Grant a one-year time extension to exercise Vesting Tentative Tract Map No. 5430, which authorizes the division of 179.57acres into 561 residential lots in the R-1(c) (Single-Family Residential, 6,000 square-foot minimum parcel size, Conditional) and R-1-C(c) (Single-Family Residential, 9,000 square-foot minimum parcel size, Conditional) Zone Districts.
  - LOCATION: The subject property is located on the north side of Millerton Road between Winchell Cove Road and the Friant-Kern Canal, within the Millerton New Town Specific Plan, approximately 1.8 miles east of the unincorporated community of Friant (APNs: 300-021-27S, 300-032-12S, 300-340-01S, 300-340-03S, 300-340-30S, 300-032-66S) (Sup. Dist. 5).

## PLANNING COMMISSION ACTION:

At its hearing of May 19, 2022, the Commission, as part of its Consent Agenda, considered the Staff Report and determined that the requested one-year time extension was warranted.

A motion was made by Commissioner Chatha and seconded by Commissioner Arabian to grant the requested one-year time extension for Tentative Tract Map No. 5393.
