The goal of the program is to provide DBH persons served with temporary, on-site child care so that they may have the ability to receive the necessary services from the Fresno County Department of Behavioral Health. We are also working towards complying with the CARF performance measures. Reading and Beyond (RAB) plans to incorporate monthly educational themes and stations into the daily schedule of the Supervised Childcare Sites in order to facilitate educational and enrichment activities. The value of this service has proven effective because without childcare services, parents have expressed that they would often have to miss their appointments due to lack of childcare in previous years.

The RAB Supervised Child Care Program was asked to close in April 2020 due to everyone being asked to telework due to the Covid-19 pandemic and did not re-open to provide any services during FY 2020-2021.
