- 1) Covered Shelter Development, including seating and Bulletin Boards/Displays
- 1) A covered 50 ft. by 100 ft. shelter was completed on February 20, 2013, with parking around the shelter. The shelter can seat over 300 people and has a bulletin board inside with mental health information, brochures, and emergency contact numbers.
- 2) Land Preparation & Farming/Gardening of traditional crops
- 2) The 2.5 acres of land was plowed and prepared for planting from November 2012 through March 2013. Participants have farmed a number of traditional crops such as green mustard, onions, cilantro, Currently consumers are planting many varieties of egg plants, bell peppers, chili peppers, beans, and corn.

- **3)** Project Coordinator, Amandip S Gill and Site coordinator, Nachhatar S Dhaliwal oversee garden/site operations and activities.




