PUBLIC NOTICE

MEASURE TO BE VOTED ON AND NOTICE OF DATE FIXED FOR SUBMITTING ARGUMENTS ON THE CITY OF SANGER EXTENSION OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY SALES TAX MEASURE

Notice is hereby given that a special municipal election for the following measure is to be voted on at the Consolidated General Election to be held in the City of Sanger on Tuesday, November 5, 2024.

SYNOPSIS OF MEASURE

ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE APPROVING EXTENSION OF CURRENT 3/4 CENT TRANSACTIONS AND USE TAX FOR PUBLIC SAFETY ONLY, WITH NO INCREASE IN CURRENT TAX RATE, UNTIL ENDED BY CITY VOTERS.

The proposed ordinance would approve the extension of the City's current 3/4 cent sales tax dedicated and expended only for Police, Fire, Paramedic, 9-1-1 Emergency Response and Gang/Drug Prevention. The authority to levy the tax would continue until ended by the City voters.

Arguments for or against the measure may be submitted to the Fresno County Clerk/Elections, 2221 Kern St., Fresno, CA 93721, no later than Monday, August 12, 2024, by 5:00 p.m. Paper copies of arguments must be submitted with original signatures, as well as by email to clerk-elections@fresnocountyca.gov in MS Word format. No argument shall exceed 300 words in length. Arguments may be submitted by the legislative body, or any member or members of the legislative body authorized by that body, or any individual voter who is eligible to vote on the measure, or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of voters and associations. If an argument is signed by more than five persons, the names of only the first five persons signing, determined by the order in which their signatures appear, shall be printed with the argument.

Only one argument for and one argument against each measure will be selected for printing and distribution to the voters. Preference and priority in selection will be given in the order named: (1) The legislative body, or member or members of the legislative body authorized by that body; (2) The individual voter or bona fide association of citizens, or combination of voters and associations, who are the bona fide sponsors or proponents of the measure; (3) Bona fide associations of citizens; (4) Individual voters who are eligible to vote on the measure. Any argument submitted shall not be changed after Monday, August 12, 2024, by 5:00 p.m.

ALL ARGUMENTS submitted shall be verified in substantially the following form:

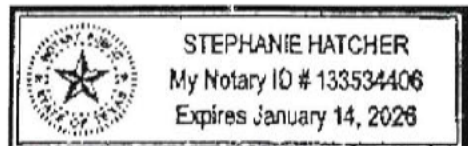
