OUR PRETRIAL MISSION

 The Fresno County Probation Pretrial Services goals are to help ensure pretrial defendants appear for scheduled court appearances and to not endanger community safety.

PRETRIAL SERVICES

- Fresno County Probation Pretrial Services consists of two units: Pretrial Assessment and Pretrial Monitoring.
- The Pretrial Assessment Unit is responsible for gathering criminal and demographic information about the person arrested. The information is reported to the Court, who then makes a release decision while the case is pending.
- If the defendant is suitable for Pretrial Release, they will be directed to the Pretrial Monitoring Unit.
- The Pretrial Monitoring Unit will make appropriate referrals for services and monitor defendants in accordance with conditions set by the Court and/or as directed by the probation officer.
- Pretrial Services is here to support and help guide you while your case is pending. Pretrial Services can refer you to additional services such as:
 - Providing you with court reminders and bus passes for transportation for upcoming hearings.
 - Support in navigating how to reinstate your driver's license.
 - Refer you to mental health treatment.
 - Employment assistance and job placement.
 - Substance abuse treatment.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Once you are released on Pretrial Monitoring, you need to report in person to one of the two locations: 2135 Fresno Street, Suite 101 or 2171 N. Fine Avenue within 24 hours of your release from custody.
- Go to all court hearings and comply with all release conditions.
- Keep in contact with your attorney!
- Update your Probation Officer with the best way to contact you, whether by phone, text, or e-mail address.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What does a defendant do after being released on pretrial supervision?

The defendant must report to the Pretrial Office the next business day unless ordered by the Court to report another day.

What happens if a defendant fails to contact or report to the Pretrial Office?

A warrant may be issued for the defendant's arrest.

Is there a cost to participate in the Pretrial Release Program and GPS?

There are no costs associated with Pretrial Services.

When does a defendant terminate pretrial supervision?

When the defendant's case has been resolved and the Court terminates Pretrial Release.
