D. Strategic Plan

The Analyst's contact at CSUF does not think a presentation would work well for their class at this time due to hybrid scheduling. They asked for written information that can be passed on to other faculty. The Analyst will send a PDF of the recruitment flyer.

The committee voted to have the Analyst print more flyers to give to the IHSS SWs. They will provide information to clients during home visits and leave one if they show interest. 10,000 flyers will be ordered; if there are budget restraints, the committee agreed that a new amount can be discussed via email between committee meetings. Additionally, a survey is in the works for IHSS recipients. DSS can include a question asking if the participant is aware of the committee and include the Analyst's contact information.

E. <u>Director's Report</u>

Joy Moreno announced that she is retiring from the County at the end of March.

The State will send out IHSS Care Economy payments around the end of January. These \$500 payments will be given to providers who worked for at least two months during the period of March 2020 – March 2021. Eligibility for payment will be determined by analyzing data pulled directly from CMIPS. Providers do not need to request or apply for the payment; they will automatically receive it if they are eligible.

The State will also send out notices to providers and recipients regarding an update to the Public Health Order issued in December 2021 to will include booster shots. Providers can claim a medical or religious exemption, but that information will be kept between the provider and recipient; DSS will not collect any of that information.

IHSS

SWs continue to catch up on reassessments, and to make home visits to complete assessments while obtaining the majority of the application information by phone prior to the visit. The goal is to keep the visit as brief as possible to maintain the health and safety of the client and SW.

Due to the quick spread of the Omicron variant, County staff are again telecommuting. Please remember to leave a voice mail when contacting SWs and to allow 24 hours for a return call.

IHSS PA

PPE is still available for providers and recipients by calling PARCC at 600-6666, or the IHSS SW. Kits will be sent via U.S. mail. SWs also take kits with them on home visits.

IHSS PA staff continue to follow health and safety protocols with providers when they come to the office to turn in their ID and Social Security cards to complete the enrollment process. The average time providers spend in the office is 10 minutes.

PARCC is experiencing an increase in phone calls regarding W2s, which will be issued at the end of January. Providers can request a copy in ESP if they do not receive one. At this time, if providers fill out a change of address request it will not affect where their W2 is sent. They have already been processed using the address on file.

IHSS PA continues to enroll new providers, and reports that usage of secure document submission on their website is increasing.
